STEPS FOR INSTALLATION

To Install Quality Order Module follow bellow step:

- Plugins > Add New > Upload Plugins > Select Quantity Dropbox from your Directory and Install it.
- Activate the module

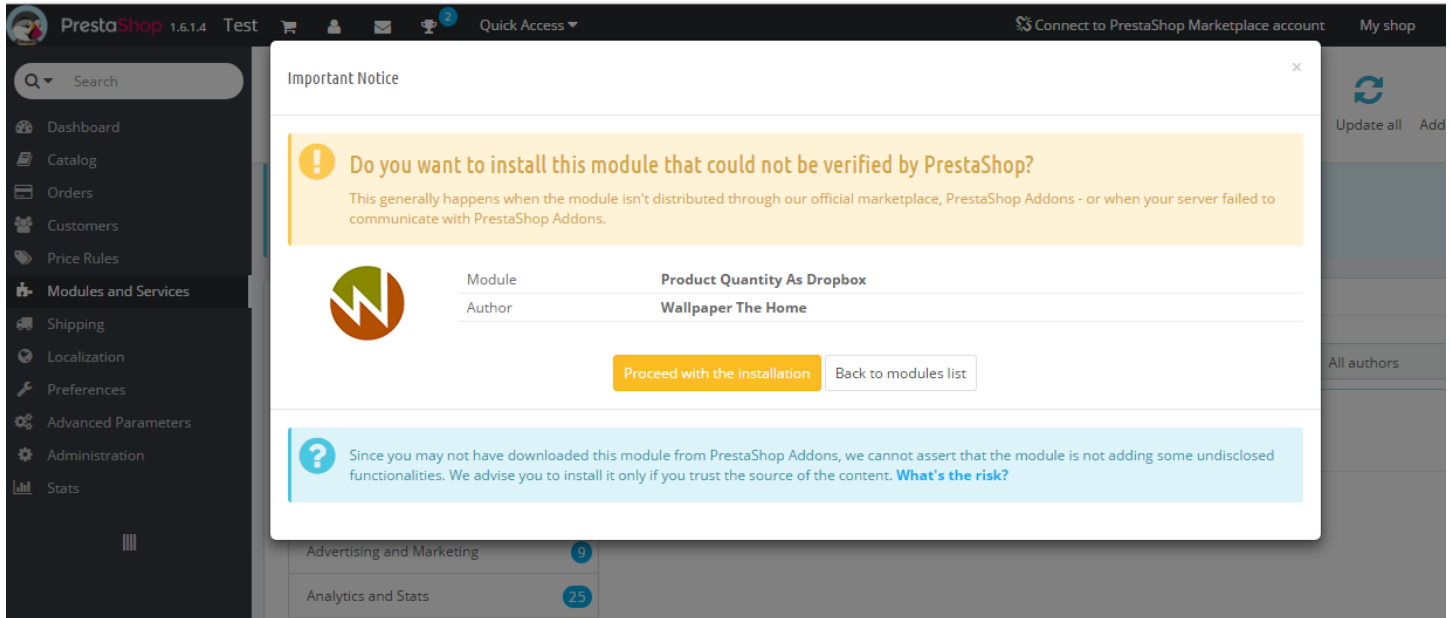

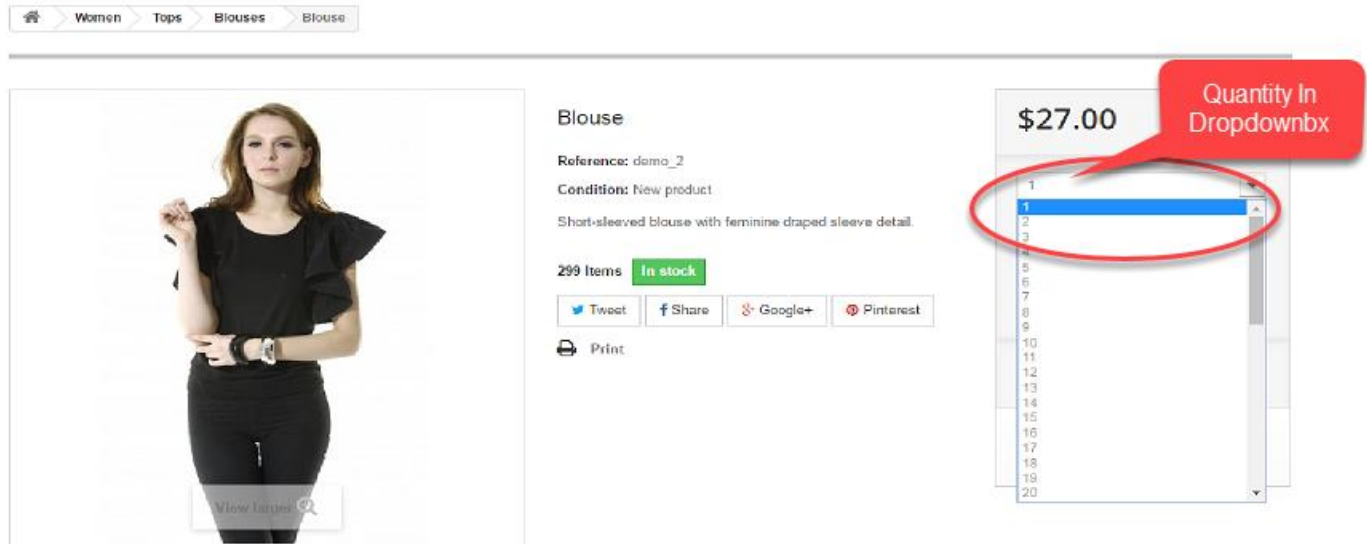
2. Before the installation, set the quantity

 - b. In order to change the default value – refer below:



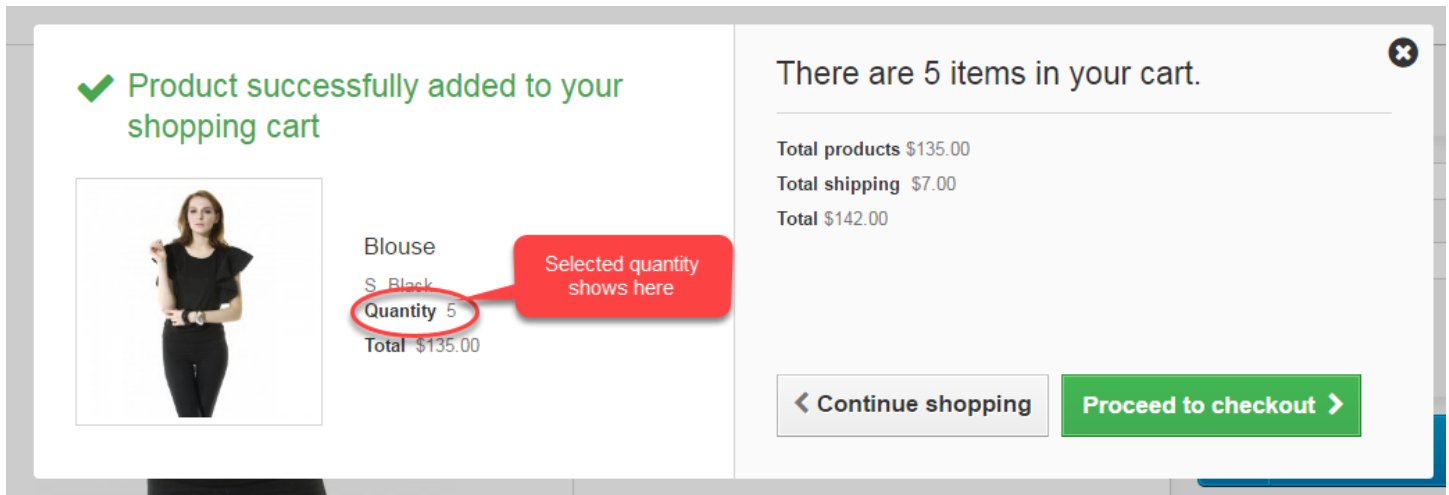
3. After the installation:

- f. The product is successfully added in the cart









? This interface allows you to manage available quantities for sale for products. It also allows you to manage product combinations in the current shop. You can choose whether or not to use the advanced stock management system for this product.
